As a key member of both the Africa team and our Research department, you will work directly with our East Africa Regional Manager. You will co-develop, implement, and deliver on the M&E process and Research studies for agroforestry, supply chains and ecosystem restoration projects in Africa. Your activities will start in East Africa (Ethiopia, Uganda, Kenya) and progressively expand to West and possibly Northern Africa, and will include, but will not be limited to:

- **Conducting and Delivering on M&E and Research**

Design and Implement research protocols for budgeted studies, possibly conduct fieldwork, analyze the results using Excel Suite and statistical tools, and deliver high-quality reports. The M&E and research usually focus on dimensions of agronomics (yields, adoption of practices), livelihoods (socio-economic features of communities), soils (fertility, health), biodiversity (birds, insects, etc.), carbon sequestration (biomass inventories, tree monitoring), and water (quantity, quality).

- **Supervision of Research**

Hire and supervise consultants and field teams to conduct and deliver on budgeted studies and M&E processes. Train local partners to conduct studies and implement M&E processes. Manage contracts and studies' budgets.
