Responsibilities include but are not limited to:

- **Project development and monitoring**

Be accountable for all project commitments delivery at regional level: plan, coordinate and report on all operations (feasibility studies, field visits, projects, targets) and key deliverables.

Assess the feasibility of new ecosystem restoration projects in West Africa (community engagement & project design).

Coordinate with the Regional Manager and Research team, the monitoring of project impacts and propose a strategy for each study (planning, ressources...)

Analyze field data and make proposals for improvement.

Participate to field missions such as feasibility studies or client visits.

Develop strategy and implementation plans for long-term autonomy and sustainability of projects.

- **Team Management**

Manage the team of all project developers in the region to help them to grow : follow-up, employee evaluation, guide and advice for any new activity (benchmark, business model, set up..), strategic decision-making.

Ensure the team's training and well-being (trainings, visits, regional workshops).

- **Financial Management & Regional administration**

Develop project budgets and be responsible for the execution of sub-regional budget as well as the analysis and reporting.

Take strategic decisions on costs and provisions use, in coordination with the Regional Manager.

Validate contracts and payments in coordination with the Admin & Finance Manager.
