PUR Projet is looking for an experienced Agronomist for the position of Project Manager China, with successful technical experiences in Agroforestry, Regenerative Agriculture, or Agro-ecology, to support its development in China and improve agriculture practices on its projects and client's supply-chains. The Project Manager will design, coordinate, supervise and monitor community projects in China (and potentially Japan and Korea) and conduct Sustainable Supply Chain Diagnosis (DIAG), under the supervision of PUR Projet Senior Projects Coordinator East Asia. The successful candidate will be based in Kunming, Yunnan province, China.

The main responsibilities will be:

- Designing, implementing, supervising and monitoring the activities of agroforestry projects in China (Yunnan, Hebei, etc.). This includes:
 - Hire, manage and train the field team.
 - Set-up, plan, coordinate and monitor the implementation of projects activities.
 - Monitor projects outputs : adapt and implement data collection tools, consolidate and analyze field data. Coordinate the monitoring of projects impacts.
 - Update reporting and communication tools.
- Partnership management:
 - Build, train and manage local partners (cooperatives). Control quality of implementation, improve proceedings.
 - Manage project contracts & project budgets.
- Supply chain analysis and sustainable supply-chain project development.
 - Conducting Sustainable Supply Chain Diagnosis (DIAG) audits on several strategic agriculture and animal supply-chains, in China and East-Asia.
 - Designing, implementing, supervising, following-up and monitoring of new insetting projects to be set-up on agriculture and animal supply-chains.
